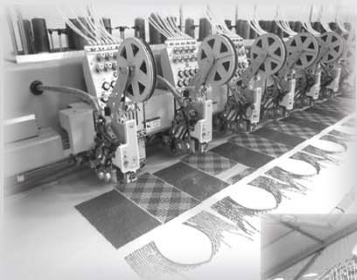

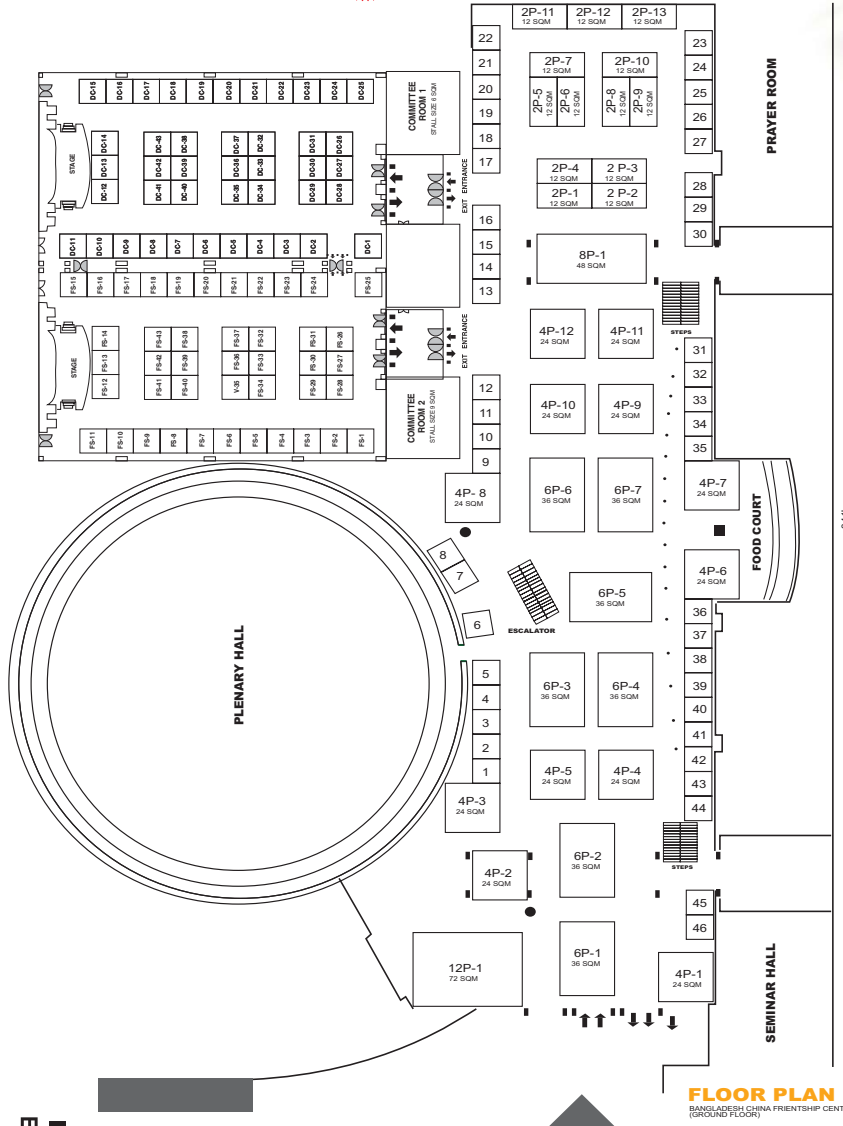

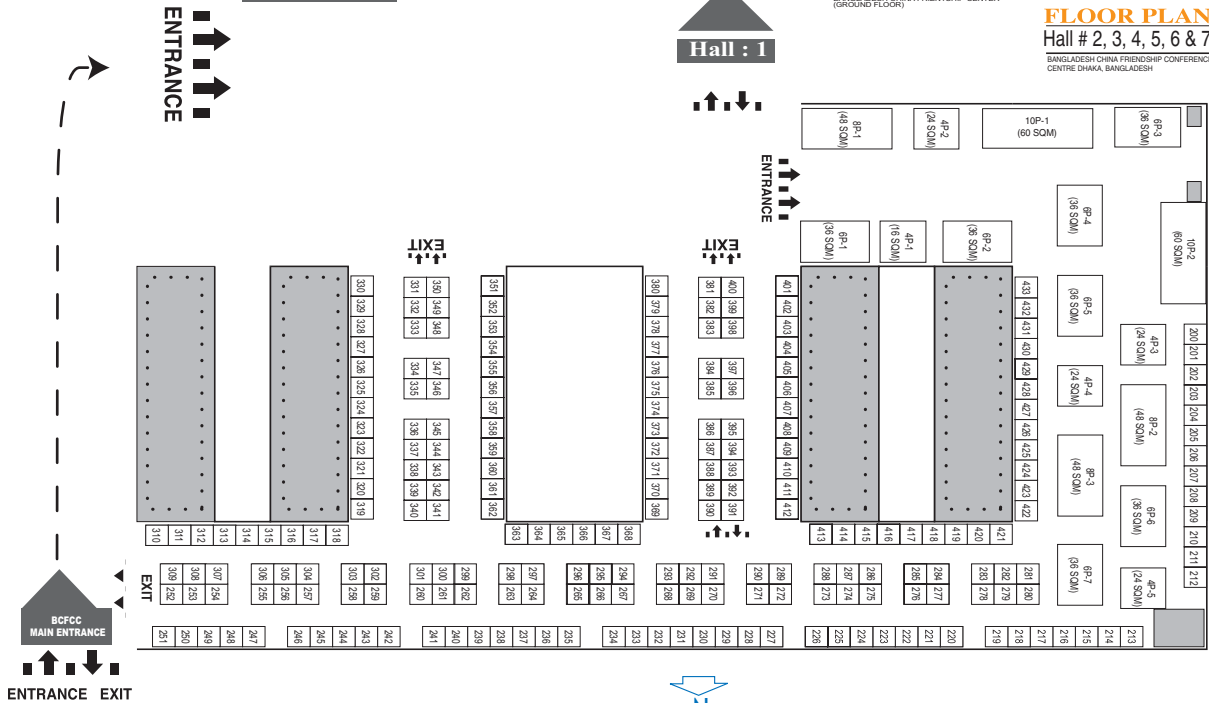


HALL -1

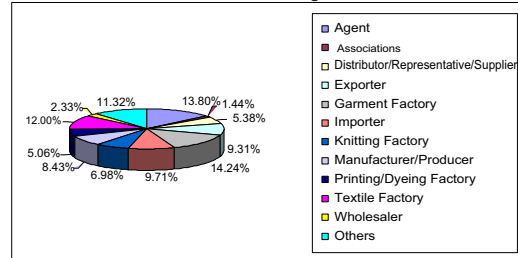
POST SHOW REPORT' OF 9TH TEXTTECH BANGLADESH 2008

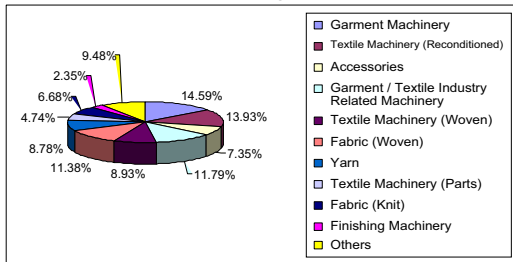
Total number of visitors were 17,000 +, categorized as follows,

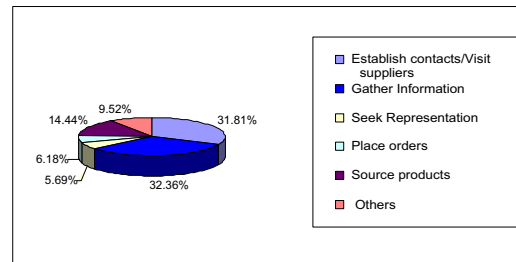

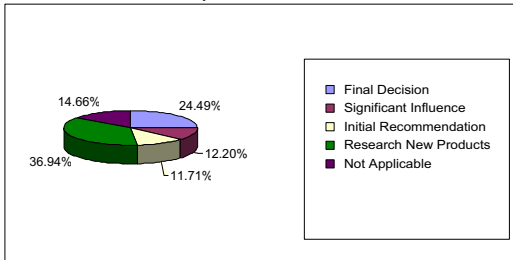

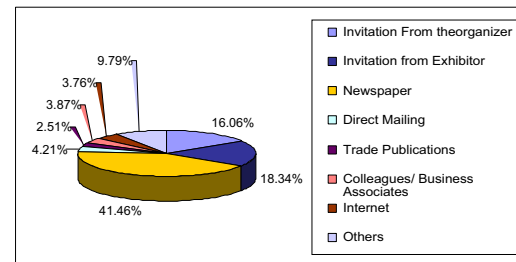
